The announcement for new factory construction of Nippon Nozzle

Nakamura Choukou Co., Ltd. (the "Company") hereby at the board meeting held on December 24, 2021,

passed the resolution on the construction of the new factory and the investment proposal for the large

Meltblown Spinneret and T-die to Nippon Nozzle Co., Ltd. (the "Subsidiary").

1. Objective of investment

Our subsidiary, Nippon Nozzle Co., Ltd., who successfully realized the first domestic

production of spinnerets for chemical fibers in Japan, has been in business as a

specialized manufacturer of spinneret for chemical fibers since its establishment in 1928.

Because of the increase in global demand for face masks caused by COVID-19, Nippon

Nozzle's sales of non-woven fabric production equipment and non-woven fabric-related

spinnerets of have increased significantly, and the sales performance has shown a good

trend.

The company expects that due to the spread of the COVID-19, the demand for face

masks will stabilize. However, for the non-woven market, especially in terms of medical

gowns, diapers and other sanitary products, the global demand is high and is expected to

be long-term growth. Therefore, in the future, non-woven fabric-related market will be

one of the strategic pillars of the growth of Nippon Nozzle Co., Ltd.

However, since Nippon Nozzle Co., Ltd. does not have the machinery for large non-

woven fabric spinnerets used in sanitary products, it has not been able to deeply

participate in the large non-woven fabric market so far.

For Nippon Nozzle's future growth, it is necessary to invest in equipment that can be

used to process large non-woven spinnerets. Therefore, it was decided to invest in the

construction of new factories, office buildings, and equipment that can process large

meltblown spinnerets and T-die. This investment has been adopted as selected of the

Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry's The Program for Promoting Investment in

Japan to Strengthen Supply Chains (Second Call) .
